will be held on **Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at 6 pm.**

A professional symposium entitled

The surveyed land: 200 years of the cadastre in Slovenian Lands

will be held on **Wednesday, May 24, 2017.**

The theme of the 45th Slovenian Land Surveying Day will relate to the cadastre, as indicated in the title of the event. The theme coincides with the commemoration of the 200th anniversary of the start of the parcel-oriented cadastre in Slovenian territory. Distinguished guests from abroad and recognized experts from Slovenia will provide interesting lectures in fields related to the wide area of real property records and official spatial databases as well as to geodetic engineering in land management. Current projects in Slovenia and in other countries in the region will be presented and new approaches and challenges of the new technology in these fields will be discussed.

The symposium will be concluded with a round table discussion on the topic

Vision of the surveying profession.

The programme will be accompanied by an exhibition of companies and institutions as well as of old surveying instruments that were used in the cadastre in the Slovenian territory. The opening of the exhibition and presentation of the monograph

Surveying Instruments and Equipment in Slovenian Lands

will take place on **Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at 4:30 pm.**
