- **Text of abstract format (including the objective(s) of the paper and the originality of the research):** Times New Roman 11, 1.5 spacing (max. 500 words)
- **CONFERENCE TOPICS:** please indicate in which one of the proposed main sessions your paper will be inserted.

A short personal biography (max. 300 words as a written text) should be presented which will include:

- contacts (e-mail, telephone number, personal or institutional website)
- research activities (especially those regarding the topics of the congress)
- position
